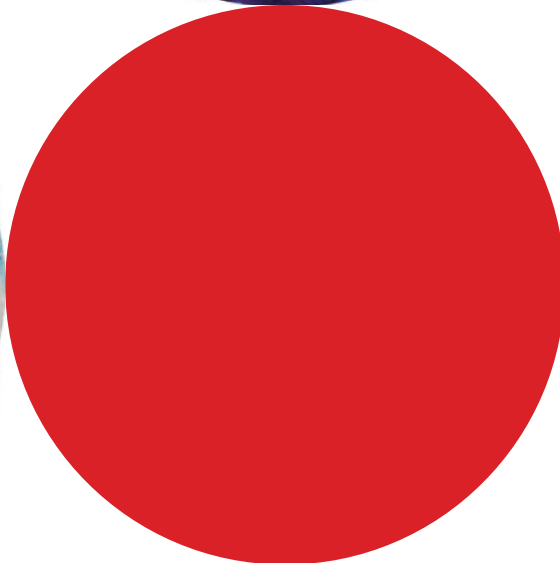
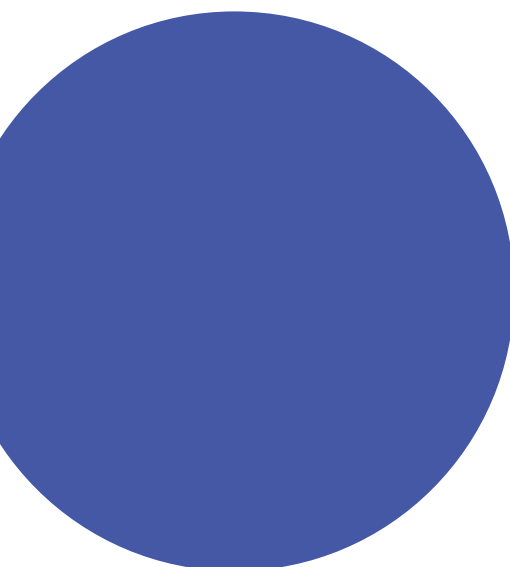

When the Reverend Canon Francis Holland founded the school in 1878, extra-curricular activities were a unique feature of the school and included pursuits such as drawing, music, needlework and botany. These days, extra-curricular clubs and societies as well as expeditions and experiences continue to form an important part of life at our school. Through their participation in the programme of activities the girls not only develop and nurture new interests, but they also learn teamwork, leadership and a sense of belonging.

There is an extraordinary range of activities on offer: everything from yoga and netball to debating and self-defence, not to mention outward bound, overseas travel and the vast range of events that our Central London location has to offer. In fact, within this booklet you will find some details of nearly one hundred clubs, activities and societies – there really should be something for everyone. That said, the girls here at Francis Holland like to demonstrate their leadership skills by establishing new societies of their own!

We hope that every pupil will take full advantage of the wide range of activities on offer. Girls in the first three years at the school generally take part in no fewer than three extra-curricular activities per week and we strongly encourage at least two clubs per week for the more senior pupils.
