

Headteacher is in running for honour

A Regent's Park headmistress has been nominated as "best head of a public school" by society bible *Tatler*.

This is the second time Francis Holland School's head Vivienne Durham – who has run the Ivor Place school since 2004 – has been up for the award.

In 2007, she was shortlisted for "best headmistress of a public school".
