FOUNDATION SCHOLARS

At the core of our bursary programme is the belief that all children, regardless of background, should be able to reach their potential through education.

Here at Francis Holland, we are committed to widening access to the outstanding opportunities that our school has to offer for those who might significantly benefit from the experience but may never have been able to consider it.

This commitment is reflected in our pledge to significantly increase the number of transformational awards offered to deserving girls. These awards provide girls with significant support, well over and beyond the cost of fees, throughout their time at the School and are specifically for those families with limited means.

Girls funded in this way are known as Francis Holland Foundation Scholars, named after the School's Founder, who was Chaplain to Queen Victoria and King Edward VII and a visionary in philanthropy and education.

The recognition of Foundation Scholars in this way highlights the contribution these girls make to the School more widely. Broadening access to an outstanding education is at the very heart of the School's bursary initiative and one which continues Francis Holland's legacy.

THE GIFT CAMPAIGN

In order to realise our ambitious philanthropic vision, we have launched the Gift Campaign, marking the most audacious fundraising endeavour in the School's history.

Our aim is to establish a £5M endowment fund over the course of the next ten years. Raising £500k per annum will enable us to add an additional full-fees award, year on year, to our existing provision. These new awards will run in perpetuity. By 2034, our aspiration is to have welcomed 10 additional full-fees Foundation Scholars to the School.

TAX EFFICIENT GIVING

For UK tax payers, giving with Gift Aid enables us to increase the value of your gift by up to 25%, at no additional cost to you.

To make a Gift Aid donation, you must pay as much Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax as the amount reclaimed by Francis Holland Schools. This is currently 25 pence per pound donated. Higher-rate tax payers who donate through Gift Aid may claim extra relief by claiming the difference between the higher rate of tax (40% and/or 45%) and the basic 20% rate of tax on the total gross value of the donation.

Marking the year of our founding, The 1878 Circle is a unique opportunity to join fellow supporters who are committed to widening access to the School.

An annual donation of £1,878 will be pivotal in supporting our ambitious new bursary programme.

For every individual who joins, donating £1,878 per month (or for every ten people who join paying £187.80 per month), we will be able to fund one annual bursary (with Gift Aid). In recognition of your support, and as a member of The 1878 Circle, you will be invited annually to two 1878 Circle receptions and other events.
