

This year we will be joining Santa (and his reindeer) as he flies across the skies, reading books from every time zone that he visits. There are multiple elements to this challenge so read on to learn all the ways you can take part!

## The challenges

**Form challenge:** Each form will be given a map with 24 time zones and. Each member of the form should put their name against at least one time zone on the map, find and read a book connected to it, and upload a review to the Library SharePoint as evidence. The form who completes the most time zones will receive a doughnut break time. (You can circumvent the globe twice!)

**Individual challenge:** Flying solo? Complete as many time zones as you can and travel the world. A4 maps are available in the library and keep a travel log documenting your adventures. Book tokens will be awarded for the most literary travelled.

**House challenge:** Once again there will be a house point awarded for each book read, so make sure to make a list of all your Advent Reading. Submit your list to Miss Lawrence by the end of D.E.A.R. Fortnight on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> January to ensure your books are counted.

## <u>The rules</u>

- Books can be fiction set in a country within the time zone, by an author that lives in the time zone, or a non-fiction book that is connected to a country in the time zone.
- Audio books and graphic novels both count.
- For the individual challenge, each book can only be counted once, it cannot be used for multiple locations.
