The success of this approach has been illustrated, as well of course as by the happiness of the girls and pleasant environment of the school, by the excellent academic results consistently achieved by FHS students in public exams. In Summer 2021, an exceptional 49% of A Level grades awarded were A* and 96% A*-B, while 91% of GCSE grades were A*-A. Sixth Formers go on to take a variety of paths including Oxbridge and Russell Group universities, Art Foundations and Drama Courses and a variety of US and Canadian universities including NYU, Columbia, Georgetown, McGill and Northeastern.

The sky's the limit for FHS girls and what a fitting way to celebrate the beginning of another formative year of their education.
