

Quondam Travel Scholarship Guidelines

- 1. Members of the current Sixth Form and Polished Corners, aged 25 and under on the closing application date, are eligible to apply for the Quondam Travel Scholarship. You can only be awarded the scholarship once.
- 2. Applications for the Quondam Travel Scholarship 2025 must be received by 22nd July 2025.
- 3. The scholarship aims to help those who are in education or in unpaid or poorly paid employment, who wish to broaden their education and experience by giving to others which is likely to involve overseas travel, but travel through UK could be considered.

The scholarship award is £1,000. -Applications must be for journeys which benefit others and involve elements of education, e.g. building an essential bridge, learning about wildlife, providing teaching or medical aid etc.

- 4. Applications must include the following information at a minimum:
 - Full name
 - Date of birth
 - Email address
 - Telephone number
 - Years at FHS, Regent's Park
 - Travel journey to and from destination, other destinations (if relevant) and dates pf travel.
 - Benefit to others
 - Benefit to you
 - Elements of education
 - The difference the Travel Scholarship would make to your travels were you to win it.
 - All costs including a detailed breakdown of travel costs identifying selected airline/train/other company including for return journey.
 - Any fundraising activities, such as crowd funding, or sponsorships already in place or for which you will apply.
 - Your reasons why you should be awarded the Scholarship

Current Sixth Formers must also include:

• Details of post school plans such as gap years, further education, employment

Polished Corners must also include

- Achievements and activities, including employment (if any) since leaving school
- 5. Applications will be considered at a committee meeting of Quondam once a year, usually held in May.

- 6. The winning applicant may be contacted by email or telephone. If for any reason a winner cannot travel, the Committee reserves the right to decide if or how to allocate the Fund award.
- 7. Quondam regrets that they will not be able to consider applications which are incomplete or submitted after the deadline.
- 8. You may be contacted for further information.
- 9. All entries should be sent directly to <u>quondamchair@fhs-nw1.org.uk</u> with the subject line "Quondam Travel Scholarship Entry".
- 10. An acknowledgement on receipt of the entry will be sent to the applicant by email
- 11. Successful applicants will be required to present a full report of their time abroad when they return. A maximum of 600 words with some illustrative photographs is to be emailed to quondam@fhs-nw1.org.uk for publication in the Quondam Magazine.
- 12. The winner will be expected to give a talk during a Sixth Form lecture or whole school assembly to demonstrate the use of the award and encourage girls to enter. The winner will also be expected to write an article about their journey for publication in Polished Corners, the Quondam magazine.
